Group-B

- iii) Critically examine the role of woman in Ibo society as represented in *Things Fall Apart*.
- iv) How does Marquez relate the themes of love and sickness in his *Love in the Time of Cholera?*

2. Attempt any four of the following questions. $4\times5=20$

- i) Comment briefly on the lover's state of mind as revealed in "Tonight I can Write".
- ii) Write a short note on the significance of the initial courtship between Florentino Ariza and Fermina Daza.
- iii) "...brutish necessity wipes its hands/ Upon the napkin of a dirty cause". Explain the phrases 'brutish necessity' and 'dirty cause'.
- iv) What does the Mountain symbolize in "The Voice of the Mountain"?
- v) Comment on Ikemefuna as a tragic figure in *Things Fall Apart*.
- vi) Give your opinion about the motif of music and ritual in Soyinka's *A Dance of the Forest*.
- vii) Define 'Globalization'. Name at least one Indian text with its author that reflects the spirit of globalization.
- viii) "Where shall I turn, divided to the vein".

 Comment on the divided loyalties of the poet.

3. Attempt any ten of the following questions. $10\times2=20$

i) Why does the speaker think that this may be the last poem he writes for her in "Tonight I Can Write"?

- ii) What are the two meaning of Walcott's title "A Far Cry from Africa"?
- iii) What personality of the mountain gets rejuvenated with the winds in the poem of Mamang Dai that you have read.
- iv) Who is the second wife of Okonkwo? Why does Okonkwo beat her?
- v) Who owns the transient hotel in *Love in the*Time of Cholera? Who was given a hotel-room free of cost?
- vi) Explain the metaphor of Forest Head in Wole Soyinka's *A Dance of the Forest*.
- vii) Why does the colonization of mind possess more serious impact than the physical colonization?
- viii) What do you mean by 'identity politics?
- ix) What happened to the twins born in Umuofia?
- x) Who coined the term 'the White Man's Burden'? To which nation was this poem originally addressed?
- xi) Who is Chielo in Things Fall Apart?
- xii) What was the purpose of bringing the Dead man and the Dead woman back to the land of the living in Soyinka's *A Dance of the Forest*.

- xiii) Define 'liminality'.
- xiv) Where did the Mau Mau uprising take place?
 What was the intention of the Mau Mau rebels?
- xv) What was the occupation of Jeremiah de Saint Amour?
