## Editor

**Navroz K. Dubash** is professor at the Centre for Policy Research, New Delhi, India. He has been engaged in the climate debate as a researcher, policy advisor, and activist for over 25 years. In 1990, he was instrumental in establishing the global Climate Action Network, participated in the climate negotiations in Rio de Janeiro in 1992, and has since written widely about climate politics, policy, and governance at international, national, and local scales.

He has been involved in informing Indian government policymaking on climate change over the last decade, and is also active in policy committees on energy, air, and water policy. He serves on the editorial boards of several journals, including *Climate Policy* (as associate editor), *Global Environmental Politics*, and *Energy Research in Social Science*, and is currently coordinating lead author for a chapter on national policies for the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change. In 2015, he was conferred the 12th TN Khoshoo Memorial Award in recognition of the impact of his work on Indian climate change policy and the international discourse on global climate governance.

Dubash holds an MA and PhD in energy and resources from the University of California, Berkeley, California, USA, and an AB in public and international affairs from Princeton University, New Jersey, USA.
