b) Why does the poet refer to the West Wind as both a destroyer and a preserver? Comment.

OR

Discuss Keats as a poet of sensuousness with reference to "Ode to a Nightingale".

c) Comment on the themes of money and marriage as illustrated in Pride and Prejudice.

OR

- Write a note on the significance of the title of Jane Austen's Pride and Prejudice.
- d) Comment on the elements of humour and pathos in Charles Lamb's essay "Dream Children: A Reverie".

2. Attempt any four of the following questions. $4 \times 5 = 20$

- "What the hammer? what the chain, In what furnace was thy brain? What the anvil? what dread grasp.
 - Dare its deadly terrors clasp?"— Explain.
- ii) "...that serene and blessed mood" Bring out the idea contained in the line.
- iii) Critically comment on the opening sentence of Jane Austen's novel Pride and Prejudice.
- iv) "We are nothing, less than nothing and dreams" Comment.
- v) Write a short note on the salient features of Romanticism.
- vi) How did the French Revolution influence Romanticism?

- vii) Discuss Charles Lamb as an essayist.
- viii) Write a note on 'Nature' as presented in Romantic Literature.

3. Attempt any ten of the following questions. $10 \times 2 = 20$

- a) "We are called by his name."—Who are referred to here as 'we'? Whose name is suggested here?
- b) Whom does the poet address as 'my dearest friend' in his poem "Tintern Abbey"? What does the person represent for him?
- Why does the poet repeat 'five' in the beginning of the poem "Tintern Abbey"?
- d) What did Christabel see behind "the huge, broadbreasted, old oak tree"?
- Who are referred to as the 'pestilence-stricken multitudes? Why are they called so?
- Why does Shelley want the West Wind to make him his lyre?
- Name the flowers mentioned in "Ode to a Nightingale"?
- h) What is Lethe? How is it associated with "Ode to a Nightingale"?
- What is the first title of Pride and Prejudice? In which year was it published?
- Why did Charlotte Lucas accept the marriage proposal of Mr. Collins in Pride and Prejudice?

- k) Why is Lamb's essay "Dream Children" called "A Reverie"?
- What is the meaning of the phrase "bachelor armchair"?
- m) Name two novelists of the Romantic Period along with one work of each of them.
- n) Name two satirical poems of Lord Byron along with 'their year of publication.
- o) Who are called the Lake District poets?
